

## Curriculum Policy Statement

Curriculum of a higher education institution reflects the values the institution stands for. Shaheed Major Harminderpal Singh (Shaurya Chakra) Government College, Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar (Mohali) aims to offer education through a curriculum that shapes the students holistically. The Curriculum delivery not only considers intellectual, vocational and social dimensions but also promote civic behavior, social cohesion and spiritual development.

The institution tries to deliver a curriculum that is relevant to the changing circumstances and environment; hence it is subjected to timely evaluation and restructuring. The curriculum delivery of the institute aims to instill the quality of discipline, effective communication and competitive spirit.
