The term teaching by fellows is very broadly defined for this purpose. Your teachers may assign them a task including helping out in laboratory demonstrations or a classroom teaching. The teaching engagement that

is expected from Prime Minister's Research Fellows is one hour per week on an average. This translates into 52 hours a year. The preparation time put by the fellow is also to be counted at par with the actual interaction hours with the students. Therefore, for classroom teaching it is effectively 26 contact hours and and equal hours for the preparation.

There is no payment required for the fellow. All that we would request at the time of annual review of the fellow is a letter on the official letterhead from the Head of the Department or Head of the institution mentioning total hours and the duration when the teaching contribution was made.


